ADJUSTING TO CIVILIAN TESTING FORMATS

UTILIZING VETERAN-SPECIFIC RESOURCES AND SUPPORT

EMPLOYER SPONSORSHIP AND VETERAN HIRING PROGRAMS

SOME EMPLOYERS, ESPECIALLY THOSE WITH VETERAN HIRING INITIATIVES, PROVIDE SPONSORSHIP OR REIMBURSE CERTIFICATION COSTS. VETERANS SHOULD INQUIRE ABOUT SUCH PROGRAMS DURING JOB INTERVIEWS OR THROUGH VETERAN EMPLOYMENT SERVICES.

SCHOLARSHIPS AND GRANTS FOR VETERAN STUDENTS

VARIOUS FOUNDATIONS AND NON-PROFITS OFFER SCHOLARSHIPS TARGETED AT VETERANS PURSUING FURTHER EDUCATION AND CERTIFICATIONS. RESEARCHING AND APPLYING FOR THESE CAN EASE FINANCIAL BURDENS.

SUCCESS STORIES: VETERANS WHO HAVE THRIVED AFTER CP CERTIFICATION

NUMEROUS VETERANS HAVE TRANSFORMED THEIR POST-SERVICE CAREERS BY OBTAINING CP CERTIFICATIONS. FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT ARE CP EXAMS FOR VETERANS?

CP EXAMS, OR COMPENSATION AND PENSION EXAMS, ARE MEDICAL EVALUATIONS CONDUCTED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS TO ASSESS THE SEVERITY OF A VETERAN'S SERVICE-CONNECTED DISABILITIES FOR BENEFITS DETERMINATION.

WHY ARE CP EXAMS IMPORTANT FOR VETERANS?

CP EXAMS PROVIDE THE VA WITH NECESSARY MEDICAL EVIDENCE TO ACCURATELY RATE A VETERAN'S DISABILITY, WHICH DIRECTLY AFFECTS THE AMOUNT OF COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS THEY RECEIVE.

HOW CAN VETERANS PREPARE FOR A CP EXAM?

VETERANS SHOULD BRING ALL RELEVANT MEDICAL RECORDS, BE HONEST ABOUT THEIR SYMPTOMS, AND ARRIVE ON TIME. IT'S ALSO HELPFUL TO WRITE DOWN THEIR SYMPTOMS AND HOW THE DISABILITY AFFECTS DAILY LIFE.

CAN VETERANS REQUEST A RESCHEDULE FOR THEIR CP EXAM?

YES, VETERANS CAN REQUEST TO RESCHEDULE THEIR CP EXAM BY CONTACTING THE VA OR THE THIRD-PARTY CONTRACTOR CONDUCTING THE EXAM, PREFERABLY WITH A VALID REASON SUCH AS ILLNESS OR EMERGENCY.

WHAT HAPPENS IF A VETERAN MISSES A CP EXAM?

IF A VETERAN MISSES A CP EXAM WITHOUT NOTIFYING THE VA, THEIR DISABILITY CLAIM MAY BE DELAYED OR DENIED DUE TO LACK OF MEDICAL EVIDENCE.

ARE CP EXAMS ONLY FOR PHYSICAL DISABILITIES?

NO, CP EXAMS ASSESS BOTH PHYSICAL AND MENTAL HEALTH CONDITIONS RELATED TO SERVICE-CONNECTED DISABILITIES, INCLUDING PTSD AND OTHER PSYCHOLOGICAL DISORDERS.

CAN VETERANS BRING SOMEONE WITH THEM TO A CP EXAM?

GENERALLY, VETERANS CAN BRING A SUPPORT PERSON OR REPRESENTATIVE TO THE CP EXAM, BUT ONLY THE VETERAN AND THE EXAMINER PARTICIPATE IN THE EVALUATION PROCESS.

How long does a CP exam typically last?

A CP exam usually lasts between 30 minutes to an hour, depending on the complexity of the disability being evaluated.

Will the CP exam results be shared with the veteran?

Yes, veterans can request a copy of their CP exam report, and the VA uses the exam results to make a decision on their disability claim.

IN ADDITION TO DIRECT RECOGNITION, VETERAN-FOCUSED STUDY GROUPS AND ONLINE COMMUNITIES HAVE EMERGED, FOSTERING PEER SUPPORT AND SHARED LEARNING EXPERIENCES TAILORED TO THE UNIQUE BACKGROUNDS OF CP EXAMS VETERANS.

GOVERNMENT AND NONPROFIT INITIATIVES
